

MOROCCO - Entry requirements

Passport and Visas:

a) Citizens from **Italy, Spain, Portugal, Tunisia and Argentina** need a valid passport to enter **Morocco** but **do not require a visa** for stays up to 90 days as tourists.

Standard requirement for tourists: Return ticket, information of residence during their stay or hotel reservations, evidence of funds, information of their activity in our country or any other documentation that justifies their visit in **Morocco** as tourist. This documentation may be required by the Immigration Control Officer.

For stays of more than 90 days, the long period visa of repeated 90 days up to 12 months, the applicant must contact the Moroccan Embassy or Consulates to take knowledge of the required documents. Once long period visa granted, the applicant will have to take contact, once in Morocco, with the Immigration Office to obtain a registration card.
